Programs and Services

VOCATIONAL EVALUATION

A specialized process that involves different kinds of testing to find out a person's strengths, aptitudes, needs, preferences and work interests. Job titles are identified that are a match for the person and if accommodations are needed due to a disabling condition, they are identified, too. Find out what job you can do well!

VOCATIONAL COUNSELING

Vocational counseling involves a series of individualized meetings to explore vocational interests, work personality, goals, dreams and needs. Jobs are identified that are a good match to the persons transferable skills and education and are available in the local labor market.

ON-THE-JOB ASSESSMENT

Community Based Assessment (CBA) is an on-the-job real-time functional evaluation that lets someone try-out a job! It also tells us about a person's "employability" in terms of basic work behaviors, interpersonal communication and with regards to performing a specific occupational objective.

DCC's General Entrance Criteria requires that all persons served:

Be diagnosed with an intellectual, physical and/or mental health condition which is currently stable with or without medication or other medical or psychiatric intervention

Be able to get to appointments with DCC Staff and/or employment sites independently or with the help of someone else

Abstain from the use of illicit drugs at all times while enrolled in any DCC program designed to help secure and maintain employment and be willing to participate in a pre-employment drug screen if necessary

Demonstrate respectful and safe behavior and communication with DCC Staff, referral sources and participating businesses
